EJTU FLY TYING CLASS

BEGINNERS – INTERMEDIATES

East Jersey Trout Unlimited's popular series of annual fly tying classes will commence in September 2015. Classes run for approximately ten weeks. All instructors are volunteers from East Jersey Trout Unlimited with many years of experience in the art of fly tying. This class is divided into small groups of two to four persons per instructor. The cost of the Paramus class is \$70.00 plus a \$20.00 material fee for beginners. The Paramus class meets at the Westbrook Middle School Cafeteria and the Wayne class meets at a Fire House.

BEGINNERS: Beginners will learn the techniques and materials needed to tie trout flies. Patterns will likely include a selection of nymphs, streamers, wet and dry flies. The students will gain the basic understanding needed to tie flies that will catch fish. Beginners will be supplied with tools, all materials and a Fly Tying Course syllabus. Beginner's material fee is \$20.00 payable to instructor at the first class.

INTERMEDIATES: Intermediate students will learn additional techniques and patterns to advance their understanding of the basic materials and techniques learned in the beginner's course. Intermediates must supply their own materials.
